1 (14-18 Mar)	1	Chess	An introduction to chess: learning the names and features of each piece.
	2		Techniques of chess: a more advanced look at how to play the game including some basic tactics and a more in-depth introduction
	3		Sports history, rules, examples of professional players, tips and tricks, practice.
2 (21-25 Mar)	1	At the Airport	Vocabulary, useful phrases, airport activities, role plays.
	2		At the Airplane, rules, practice situations, modeling paper plains.
	3		Airport announcement, flight reservation, planning for traveling.
3 (28 Mar-1 Apr)	1	Daily routine	Vocabulary, useful phrases, daily routine from people from different countries, role plays.
	2		Ordering in a restaurant: how to order different cuisines at a restaurant focusing on cultural differences and how to embrace them.
	3		Directions: Focusing on how to get around, this can range from how to find different places at school, then onto street knowledge.
4 (04-08 Apr)	1	Art	Vocabulary, useful phrases, creating comic book stories in English.
	2		Different artists and styles- learning about famous artists and the style in which they are famous for. Students can create a basic portrait in the style of their favorite artists; i.e. Andy Warhol.
	3		Students will make a presentation about their preferred style of art, showcasing the unique styles and creative process.
5 (11-22 Apr)	1	Music	Students will listen to different styles of music and learn a basic history of each genre. E.g Rock n roll, techno, pop, rap.
	2		Music: groundbreaking artists who define music. Student's will learn about legendary musicians who are reknown as the godfather's of music.
	3		Presentation: student's will make a presentation about their favorite musician highlighting topics from previous lessons.

6 (25-29 Mar)	1	Sports	Different sports and how they are played: student's will learn about different team and solo competitive sports. They will learn a basic history of each sport, the rules and where the sports are most popular.
	2		Legend's of sports: student's will learn about some of the biggest and greatest sports stars of all time: Mohammed Ali, Cristiano Ronaldo, Michael Jordan.
